

How to Download Audio Books and Transfer to an MP3 Player in the Seward Memorial Library

1. Visit the Nebraska OverDrive Website:
nebraska.lib.overdrive.com
2. Log in to your account by clicking on "My Account," choosing your library and typing in a simple password (ask a librarian).
3. Search or browse for a title that you would like to download. Clicking on a title name or book cover will take you to a page with more information. (see below) You can view the release date, duration, file size, description and more. You can choose to listen to an excerpt of the book, recommend the title to a friend, add it to your cart or place a hold on it if it is currently unavailable.
4. When you find an available title that you want to check out, click on "Add to Cart."

5. You can continue browsing for more titles or proceed to checkout. You may check out up to 3 titles at a time. The checkout period is 14 days and there is no way to return them before that time is up. If you check out your maximum of 3, you won't be able to get any more until the 14 days are up.
6. At any time you can click on "My Cart" and click on "Proceed to Checkout." Review any important notes and then click on "Confirm check out." The title(s) will then be available to download.

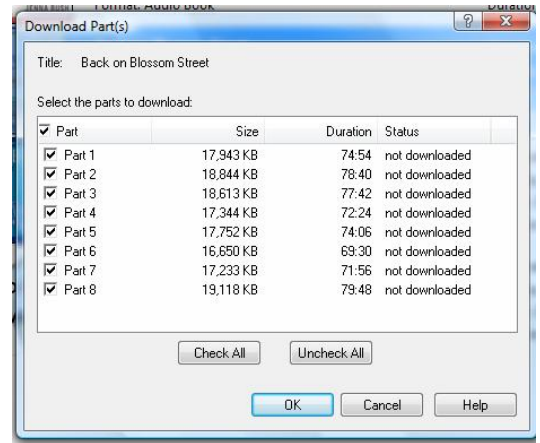

7. Click on “Download.” The OverDrive Media Console will open. Use the default folder and click on OK.
8. The Download Parts screen will open. Each audio book is divided into parts of approximately one hour of listening time each. Choose to download all of the parts at once. Click on OK. You can track the progress of your download at the bottom of the OverDrive Media Console.
9. After the part(s) have finished downloading, plug your MP3 player into the computer and click on the “Transfer” button in the OverDrive Media Console.



10. Close the OverDrive Media Console.
11. Click on the “Sign Out” button on the Nebraska OverDrive website.
12. Restart your computer.
